## HOT WEATHER SPECIMEN SUBMISSION:

Hot dry weather came early this year and will probably stay late. We have recently seen several specimens damaged by heat at a level that testing results will be compromised. One of the most frequent heat associated damage to specimens is hemolysis which occurs with whole blood. The best guideline we can provide is to always ship <u>any</u> fresh tissue or blood with cold packs and insulation. You can't go wrong keeping the specimens cool.
